

# Can you add to super?

Work Test or Work Test Exemption declaration

Use this form if you are aged under 75 years and want to contribute to your super. Please complete in pen using CAPITAL letters and print (X) to mark boxes. Read the Privacy Collection Statement on page 2 of this form to see how AustralianSuper uses your personal information. You should consider your debt levels, contribution caps that may apply and tax issues before adding to your super. ## 1 Work out if you can add extra to your super and claim a tax deduction

Confirm you meet one (X) of the following options, based on your circumstances:

### Work Test

I'm aged between 67-75<sup>1</sup> years and I've worked at least 40 hours in 30 consecutive days (working for gain or reward) during the financial year in which I am contributing extra to my super.

### Work Test Exemption

- I am aged between 67-75<sup>1</sup> years and:
- do not meet the Work Test in the current the financial year;
  - met the Work Test last financial year;
  - had a total superannuation balance of less than \$300,000 at the end of the last financial year;
  - have not used the Work Test Exemption to make contributions in a previous year.

Working for gain or reward can include acting as a director of a company or employment under a labour hire contract but, does not include voluntary work for charity.



**Note:** The Work Test Exemption can only be used to make voluntary contributions in the financial year you satisfy the exemption criteria. It can't be used again in subsequent years.

<sup>1</sup> If you're aged 74 your last contribution must be received by AustralianSuper within 28 days after the end of the month in which you attain the age 75.
